

Problem B. Japanese Digits

In Japanese, the digits 1 through 9 are pronounced as follows:

Digit	Japanese
1	ichi
2	ni
3	san
4	yon
5	go
6	roku
7	nana
8	hachi
9	kyuu

To read a multi-digit number, simply concatenate the Japanese readings of each digit from left to right. For example, 15 is read as `ichigo`, and 893 is read as `hachikyusan`.

What is 72 in Japanese?

Output a single string — the Japanese reading of 72.
